

## **LEAGUE PAYMENT PROCEDURES**

### **Manchester Pony League**

Payment (cash) in the concession stand following the game

### **Manchester Colt League**

Payment (cash) in the concession stand following the game

### **Bedford Babe Ruth League**

Payment (check) in concession stands either before first game or following first game of doubleheader. Don't wait until the end of the night.

### **Goffstown Babe Ruth League**

Games at Allard Park

Payment (cash or check) in concession stand following game

Games at Lions Field or Mountain View School

Payment at game by home coach

### **Sr. Babe Ruth League**

Payment (check) prior to game by home team coach

### **Londonderry Babe Ruth League**

Payment (cash or check) prior to game

### **GSBL (Granite State Baseball League)**

Payment prior to the game

**SNHMABL (19 – 30) League**

Payment (check) prior to game

**Youngsville Baseball League**

Payment (cash) in concession following game

**AAU Games**

Payment (cash or check) prior to game

**Or**

In-between games if a doubleheader

**FALL BALL LEAGUES****Wooden Bat League**

Payment at games either before (preferred) or after

**Manchester Pony and Colt Leagues**

Payment by GMBUA during week following your games

**Londonderry Baseball**

Payment at games (before or after)

**Note:**

**These are the expected procedures given to us by the leagues. There may, from time to time, be a mix up because of a variety of circumstances beyond anyone's control. Please be patient and professional with respect to this.**

**If you are paid a fee that you are uncomfortable in getting (more that you think you should get) then you may (on your own time and not in the company of your partner) return what you feel is appropriate. If you are**

**paid a fee that is less than what you were expecting, please be professional about it, question it politely and then contact your assignor.**

1. If you are scheduled to have a partner and you end up working alone then you should expect a game and a half fee.
2. If you start the game then you should expect a full game fee and please refer to **RED HIGHLIGHTED** paragraph above
3. If you show up and it starts pouring and (after the appropriate wait) are unable to start the game then you should leave. If they are working on the field then cut them some slack and let them try and get the field ready. Be patient and professional.
4. If you show up and the game was cancelled (you didn't get a call) then you are entitled to a game fee. Contact your assigner. You will need to document the event (date, site, what happened) in writing to your assigner within 5 calendar days of the event (if this is not done the umpire will own the responsibility of collecting his fee).

It is our responsibility to provide as good a product as possible to our customers at all times. We should exercise the appropriate judgement to allow the leagues to play both within the particular rules jurisdiction of their game and within the local rules that the leagues may have established for themselves. It is always up to us to be aware of those rules and where we are working. Always remind the coaches at the plate conference of the rules that they are playing under and **ALWAYS** ask if there are any "special" rules that you need to be aware of.

While we would like everything to be perfect and work smoothly, sometimes it doesn't and it is our responsibility to be both professional and reasonable when dealing with it.
